THE ARTS OF AFRICA OCEANIA AND NATIVE AMERICA FAMOUSLY INSPIRED TWENTIETH CENTURY MODERNIST ARTISTS SUCH AS PICASSO MATISSE AND ERNST THE POLITICS OF SUCH STIMULUS HOWEVER HAVE LONG BEEN HIGHLY CONTENTIOUS WAS THIS A CROSS CULTURAL DISCOVERY TO BE CELEBRATED OR JUST ONE MORE EXAMPLE OF WESTERN COLONIAL APPROPRIATION THIS REVELATORY BOOK EXPLORES CROSS CULTURAL ART THROUGH THE LENS OF SETTLER SOCIETIES SUCH AS AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND WHERE EUROPEANS MADE NEW NATIONS DISPLACING AND OUTNUMBERING BUT NEVER ECLIPSING NATIVE PEOPLES IN THIS DYNAMIC OF DISPOSSESSION AND RESISTANCE VISUAL ART HAS LOOMED LARGE SETTLER ARTISTS AND DESIGNERS DREW UPON INDIGENOUS MOTIFS AND STYLES IN THEIR SEARCH FOR DISTINCTIVE IDENTITIES YET POWERFUL INDIGENOUS ART TRADITIONS HAVE ASSERTED THE PRESENCE OF FIRST NATIONS PEOPLES AND THEIR CLAIMS TO PLACE HISTORY AND SOVEREIGNTY CULTURAL EXCHANGE HAS BEEN A TWO WAY PROCESS AND AN UNPREDICTABLE ONE CONTEMPORARY INDIGENOUS ART DRAWS ON GLOBAL CONTEMPORARY PRACTICE BUT MOVES BEYOND A BLAND AFFIRMATION OF HYBRID IDENTITIES TO INSIST ON THE ENDURING VALUES AND ATTACHMENT TO PLACE OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES

THIS BOOK IS AN INVESTIGATION OF THE WAY THE ABORIGINAL ART PHENOMENON HAS BEEN ENTANGLED WITH AUSTRALIAN SOCIETY S NEGOTIATION OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLE S STATUS WITHIN THE NATION THROUGH CRITICAL REFLECTION ON ABORIGINAL ART S IDIOSYNCRASIES AS A FINE ARTS MOVEMENT ITS VEXED RELATIONSHIP WITH MONEY AND ITS MEDIATION OF THE POLITICS OF IDENTITY AND RECOGNITION THIS STUDY ILLUMINATES THE MUTABILITY OF ABORIGINAL ART S MEANINGS IN DIFFERENT SETTINGS IT REVEALS THAT THIS MUTABILITY IS A CONSEQUENCE OF THE FACT THAT A RANGE OF GOVERNMENTAL ACTIVIST AND CIVIL SOCIETY PROJECTS HAVE APPROPRIATED THE ART S VITALITY AND METONYMIC POWER IN NATIONAL PUBLIC CULTURE AND

THAT ABORIGINAL ART IS AS MUCH A PHENOMENON OF VISUAL AND COMMERCIAL CULTURE AS IT IS AN ART MOVEMENT THROUGHOUT THESE EXAMINATIONS FISHER TRACES THE UTOPIAN AND DYSTOPIAN CURRENTS OF THOUGHT THAT HAVE CRYSTALLISED AROUND THE ABORIGINAL ART MOVEMENT AND WHICH MANIFEST THE ETHICAL CONUNDRUMS THAT UNDERPIN THE SETTLER STATE CONDITION

THIS BOOK EXPLORES THE COMPLEXITIES OF INDIGENOUS AND NON INDIGENOUS RELATIONS IN CONTEMPORARY AUSTRALIA IT UNPACKS THE CONTINUATION OF A PERVASIVE COLONIAL CONSCIOUSNESS WITHIN SETTLER COLONIAL SETTINGS BUT ALSO PROVOKES READERS TO CONFRONT THEIR OWN HABITS OF THOUGHT AND ACTION THROUGH PRESENTING A REFLEXIVE NARRATIVE THAT DRAWS ON THE AUTHOR S ENCOUNTERS WITH INDIGENOUS ARTISTS AND THEIR ARTWORK KNOWLEDGE STORIES AND LIVED EXPERIENCES THIS PROVOCATIVE AND INSIGHTFUL WORK ENCOURAGES READERS TO CONSIDER WHAT DECOLONISING MEANS TO THEM IT PRESENTS A COMPELLING AND RELEVANT ARGUMENT THAT CALLS FOR A REORIENTATION OF DOMINANT DISCOURSES FIXED WITHIN EUROCENTRIC FRAMEWORKS WHILST ALSO ADDRESSING THE DEEP COMPLEXITIES AND CHALLENGES OF LIVING WITHIN INTERCULTURAL SETTLER COLONIAL SETTINGS WHERE DIFFERENT VIEWS AND PERSPECTIVES CLASH AND COMPLEMENT ONE ANOTHER

HISTORICALLY ARTWORK HAS PLAYED A POWERFUL ROLE IN SHAPING SETTLER COLONIAL SUBJECTIVITY AND THE POLITICAL IMAGINATION OF WESTPHALIAN SOVEREIGNTY THROUGH THE CANONIZATION OF PARTICULAR VISUAL ARTWORKS AESTHETIC THEORIES AND ART INSTITUTIONS METHODS OF DISPLAY CREATIVE PRESENCE CONTRIBUTES A TRANSNATIONAL FEMINIST INTERSECTIONAL ANALYSIS OF VISUAL AND PERFORMANCE ARTWORK BY INDIGENOUS CONTEMPORARY ARTISTS WHO DIRECTLY ENGAGE WITH COLONIALISM AND DECOLONIZATION THIS BOOK MAKES THE CASE THAT DECOLONIAL AESTHETICS IS A FORM OF LABOUR AND KNOWLEDGE PRODUCTION THAT CALLS ATTENTION TO THE FOUNDATIONAL VIOLENCE OF SETTLER COLONIALISM IN THE FORMATION OF THE WORLD ORDER OF SOVEREIGN STATES CREATIVE PRESENCE ANALYZES HOW ARTISTS PURPOSEFUL SELECTION OF MATERIALS MEDIA FORMS AND PLACE MAKING IN THE EXHIBITIONS AND PERFORMANCES OF THEIR WORK REVEALS THE LIMITS OF CONVENTIONAL INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS THEORIES METHODS AND DEBATES ON SOVEREIGNTY AND PARTICIPATES IN INDIGENOUS RECLAMATIONS OF LANDS AND WATERWAYS IN WORLD POLITICS BRIAN JUNGEN S SCULPTURE SERIES PROTOTYPES FOR NEW UNDERSTANDING AND REBECCA BELMORE S FILMED PERFORMANCES VIGIL AND FOUNTAIN EXHIBIT HOW COLONIAL POWER HAS BEEN IMAGINED VISUALIZED AND INSTITUTIONALIZED HISTORICALLY AND IN CONTEMPORARY SETTLER VISUAL CULTURE THESE CONTEMPORARY VISUAL AND PERFORMANCE ARTWORKS BY INDIGENOUS ARTISTS THAT NAME THE POLITICAL VIOLENCE OF SETTLER COLONIAL CLAIMS TO EXCLUSIVE TERRITORIAL SOVEREIGNTY INTRODUCE POSSIBILITIES FOR DECOLONIZING AUDIENCES SENSIBILITIES AND POLITICAL IMAGINATION OF LANDS AND WATERWAYS

IT IS OFTEN ASSUMED THAT THE VERBAL AND VISUAL LANGUAGES OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLE HAD LITTLE INFLUENCE UPON THE CLASSIFICATION OF SCIENTIFIC LEGAL AND ARTISTIC OBJECTS IN THE METROPOLISES AND MUSEUMS OF NINETEENTH CENTURY COLONIAL POWERS HOWEVER COLONIZED LOCALS DID MORE THAN MERELY COLLECT MATERIAL FOR INTERESTED COLONIZERS IN DEVELOPING THE CONCEPT OF ANACHRONISM FOR THE ANALYSIS OF COLONIAL MATERIAL THIS BOOK WRITES THE COMPLEX BIOGRAPHIES FOR FIVE KEY OBJECTS THAT EXEMPLIFY EMBODY AND REFRACT THE TENSIONS OF NINETEENTH CENTURY HISTORY THROUGH AN ANALYSIS OF PARTICULAR LANGUAGE NOTATIONS AND DRAWINGS HIDDEN IN COLONIAL DOCUMENTS AND A REEXAMINATION OF CROSS

CULTURAL COMMUNICATION THE BOOK WRITES BIOGRAPHIES FOR FIVE OBJECTS THAT EXEMPLIFY THE TENSIONS OF NINETEENTH CENTURY HISTORY THE AUTHOR ALSO DRAWS ON FIELDWORK DONE IN COMMUNITIES TODAY SUCH AS THE GROUP OF KOORIE WOMEN WHOSE RE ENACTMENTS OF TRADITION ILLUSTRATE THE FIRST CHAPTER S POTTED HISTORY OF INDIGENOUS MEDIUMS AND DEBATES THE SECOND CASE STUDY EXPLORES BRITISH COLONIAL HISTORY THROUGH THE BIOGRAPHY OF THE PROCLAMATION BOARDS PRODUCED UNDER GEORGE ARTHUR 1784 1854 GOVERNOR OF BRITISH HONDURAS TASMANIA BRITISH COLUMBIA AND INDIA THE THIRD CASE STUDY LOOKS AT THE MAPS OF THE GERMAN EXPLORER OF INDIGENOUS TAXONOMY WILHELM VON BLANDOWSKI 1822 1878 AND THE FOURTH LOOKS AT A MULTI AUTHORED ENCYCLOPAEDIA IN WHICH BLANDOWSKI HAD TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE SUCH AS THAT IN THE WORK OF KWAT KWAT ARTIST YAKADUNA WHOSE HUNDREDS OF DRAWINGS 1862 1901 ARE THE MATERIAL BASIS FOR THE FIFTH AND FINAL CASE STUDY THROUGH THESE THREE CHARACTERS HISTORIES ART IN THE TIME OF COLONY DEMONSTRATES THE POLITICAL IMPORTANCE OF MATERIAL CULTURE BY USING OBJECTS TO REVISIT THE MUCH CONTESTED NINETEENTH CENTURY COLONIAL PERIOD IN WHICH THE COLONIAL NATIONS AS A CULTURAL AND LEGAL POLITICAL SYSTEM WERE BROUGHT INTO BEING
