between art and commercial entertainment seeking to deconstruct popular forms in order to expose their ideological function this book investigates the full range of kander and ebb s collaboration from the pure comic entertainment of 70 girls 70 1971 and curtains 2006 to more overtly serious musicals such as kiss of the spiderwoman 1992 the scottsboro boys 2010 and the visit 2014 which were less commercially successful precisely because they addressed disturbing subjects it explores how the difficult material inspired beautiful though challenging scores it also probes how the ironic counterpointing of luscious music with witty and demotic lyrics challenges the desire of a Broadway audience for escapist entertainment devoid of critical self reflection in order to create complex yet popular masterpieces of the genre this is the first volume to explicitly analyse the recurrent theatrical tropes and dramaturgical forms in kander and ebb s musicals offering an in depth introduction to their oeuvre
